Who Are We?

Orphans Africa (OA) is a non-profit 501(c)3 charity dedicated to the education of orphans in Tanzania, East Africa.

What's the Problem?

Out of a population of 67 million in Tanzania, nearly four million are orphan children, most of whom lost their parents to disease. Over half the population is under the age of 18 (World Bank 2024; UNICEF 2024). Quality of education is poor. Uniforms, shoes, books, and supplies are required to attend primary school, making it nearly impossible for any orphan to receive a basic education. Even if they receive funding, there aren't enough schools for the disproportionate

What Do We Do?

From its inception in 2007, OA has built and continues to develop six private schools for orphans in Tanzania who would otherwise likely receive little or no education. The orphans receive not only a quality education, but dormitory housing, clean water, health insurance, recreation and meals.

Unlike public schools, OA provides libraries and laboratories, a rare "hands-on" education in problem solving so that students graduate with a skill set that will enable them to be contributors to their society. OA's goal is to raise a generation of leaders—young adults who will help lead their country out of its crushing poverty.
